## From the North

- Take I-95 South to San Marco Exit #350B.
- Turn left onto Palm Avenue.

## From the South

- Take I-95 North to Prudential Drive Exit #350A.
- Turn left onto Prudential Drive.
- Turn left onto Palm Avenue.

## Parking

- From Palm Avenue, turn into Garage A.
- Complimentary valet parking also is available 7 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday; for the valet service, turn left into the Baptist Medical Pavilion loop from Prudential Drive.

The office is open from 9 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday, except holidays. A physician is always on call for emergencies. Due to the rotation of this "on call" schedule, you may occasionally be seen by another physician in the group.

## Appointments

Please call us at 904.388.6518 to schedule an appointment. Occasionally, the physicians are behind schedule due to emergencies. You will be notified if your appointment must be rescheduled. We request your understanding and cooperation if this should happen.

## New Patients

If you are a new patient, please bring your MRI films and records\* to your first appointment. If this is not possible for any reason, we ask that you reschedule your appointment.

*\* Some referring physician offices may have the capability of sending records and films to us electronically; please check with your physician.*

## Patient Questionnaire

You will be asked to fill out an extensive patient questionnaire. This information will assist us in your examination and care. All information is held in the strictest confidence.

## Insurance

Co-pays are due at the time of service. If you arrive for a visit without your co-pay, referral, authorization number, insurance card(s) or driver's license, the appointment will be rescheduled. You also will be asked to sign a form to authorize your insurance company to pay our office directly.

## Courtesy Rules

Please do not smoke, eat or drink in the office. Beepers and cell phones must be turned off while you are in the exam room.

## Appointment Cancellation

Please notify us at least 24 hours in advance if you find it necessary to cancel an appointment. This gives us the opportunity to schedule another patient at that time.

## Calls to the Office

The office staff handles all incoming calls. This allows the physician to attend to patients with a minimum of interruptions. We appreciate your patience. The staff will try to help you, and will refer your call to your physician. In emergencies, the physician will be contacted immediately.

*Please note: The physicians will not prescribe pain medication at night or on the weekend. If you have a block on your telephone, please remove it before paging the doctors.*
